Madam President, Ladies and Gentlemen,

- -We left behind a historically difficult year. **COVID-19** showed **how vulnerable and interdependent** we are.
- -We need a renewed commitment to **multilateralism**.
- -And a **human rights-based approach** is essential in responding to the pandemic.
- -We should give attention to the needs of **vulnerable groups**, including women, children, elderly, migrants, refugees, and persons deprived of their liberty.
- **-Equitable and affordable access** to vaccines, medicines and medical equipment is essential.
- -These are the principles behind our **global assistance efforts** and our provision of **free healthcare to all** at home.
- -Indeed, we assisted **157** countries and **12** international organizations in their efforts against the pandemic.
- -And in Turkey, we provide **free treatment and vaccination** for COVID-19 to all, including migrants and refugees.

Ladies and gentlemen, Dear Colleagues,

- -The promotion and protection of human rights remain a **top priority** for our Government.
- -Over the last two decades, we have undertaken **significant reforms**.
- -Obviously, there is always **room for improvement**.

- -Despite threats by multiple terror organizations, our commitment to human rights, democracy and rule of law remains firm
- -Judicial Reform Strategy and the 3 legislative amendment packages adopted last year, as well as the Human Rights Action Plan we plan to be announced soon are concrete examples.

Excellencies,

Let me share our views on some **major issues** where human rights and dignity are at stake:

- —Xenophobia, racism, Islamophobia and hate speech are on the rise.
- -The pandemic further increased these dangerous trends.
- -Offensive publications and hate speech against **Islam and Muslims** insult nearly two more than a billion believers around the world.
- -Yes, freedom of speech is key to any democracy. But this freedom does not give the right to **insult the sacred values of others**.
- -Unless we promote a **culture of living together**, we risk damaging our common **democratic values and social cohesion**.
- —**Terrorism** remains one of the leading global threats targeting human lives.
- -Just recently PKK terrorist organization murdered 13 innocent lives in northern Iraq and the world is silent again.
- -Without international solidarity and with the current double standards, we cannot eradicate this threat.

- -Having lost innocent lives to various terror groups, including the **PKK, YPG, DEASH and FETO**, we know well that terror has no specific ideology.
- —In Syria, people continue to suffer from the ongoing military offensives by regime forces and terrorist attacks.
- -In addition to **3.7 million** Syrians under temporary protection in Turkey, we contribute directly to the safety and well-being of **5 million** civilians in northern Syria.
- -Turkey is the **only corridor for UN cross-border humanitarian aid** to Syria. And even this **corridor is under attack**. It is essential to maintain this assistance.
- —As the **largest refugee hosting country** in the world, we uphold our international obligations as well as the human rights and dignity of the people we are hosting.
- -However, we are deeply concerned by the persistent practice of **pushbacks** occurring before the eyes of the **EU and FRONTEX**.
- —Israel continues to act with absolute impunity in the occupied Palestinian territories.
- -The inhumane blockade in **Gaza** and expansion of illegal settlements by Israel remain a violation of human rights.
- -Turkey will continue to support the legitimate quest of Palestinians for an **independent and sovereign State of Palestine**, based on the 1967 borders, with East Jerusalem as its capital.

- —In Libya, each day new mass graves are discovered in Tarhuna. Human Rights Council should contribute to bringing the perpetrators to justice.
- —Although they made every effort towards a settlement, the **Turkish Cypriots** continue to suffer inhumane embargoes and unjust isolation.
- -Despite these pressures, the Turkish Cypriots have their state, which thrives/functions as a vibrant democracy.
- —In **Nagorno-Karabakh**, there is now a historic opportunity for a sustainable peace.
- -We will continue to support initiatives for **peace and prosperity** in the South Caucasus based on **regional ownership**.
- -We hope that Armenia chooses to be a partner of peace. **Turkey** will reciprocate any positive steps taken by Armenia.
- -We will also continue to support the peaceful resolution of the **Abkhazia and South Ossetia** conflicts while ensuring the territorial integrity and sovereignty of Georgia.
- —Turkey supports **Ukraine's** territorial integrity, including Crimea. We will continue to support **Crimean Tatars'** aspirations to live freely and safely in their historical homeland.
- —Turkey closely follows the human rights situation in the **Xinjiang Uyghur Autonomous Region.** The findings of the UN and other international **reports are cause for concern**. We share our concerns and expectations on the matter with the Chinese authorities. We **expect transparency** on this issue.

- -While respecting **China's sovereignty and territorial integrity**, Turkey underlines the importance of protecting human rights of **Uyghur Turks** and other Muslims.
- -We continue to follow the developments regarding the possible visit of the High Commissioner's team to the region.
- -Upon China's invitation, we will also send our **own national team** to visit the region.
- —We reiterate our call to the Indian Government to ease the current restrictions in **Jammu-Kashmir**.
- -We wish for the resolution of the issue through peaceful means on the basis of relevant **UN resolutions** and the legitimate **expectations of the people** of Jammu-Kashmir.
- —Human rights violations in **Myanmar**, especially crimes committed against Rohingya, remain a source of serious concern.
- -We also **condemn the military takeover of the Government** by the Myanmar Armed Forces.

-Turkey will continue to engage with the Council for the protection and promotion of human rights for all. Thank you.
